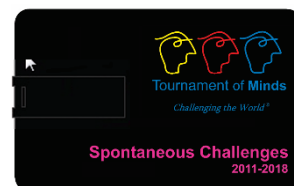
Long Term and Three Hour Challenges

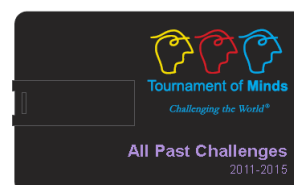
Spontaneous Challenges®
